REGULATORY BASIS

This declaration has been prepared with reference to:

Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 amended Annex III of the Cosmetics Regulation and expanded the substances subject to individual fragrance-allergen labelling requirements.

APRIFLOREN® / CAS 67663-01-8 IS NOT ITSELF IDENTIFIED AS AN INDIVIDUALLY DECLARABLE EU FRAGRANCE ALLERGEN

Symrise's current product specification identifies Aprifloren® as a minimum 95% sum of isomers, with no stabilizer.

DECLARATION

Based on the chemical identity and available current product documentation for:

APRIFLOREN® – SYMRISE

CAS Number: 67663-01-8

Aprifloren® itself is not identified as an individually declarable fragrance allergen under the EU fragrance-allergen labelling requirements reviewed.

No intentionally added stabilizer is reported by Symrise, and no declarable fragrance allergen has been identified from the available public product specification.

EU FRAGRANCE ALLERGENS IDENTIFIED: NONE

However, I recommend retaining the wording “None Identified” rather than “Not Detected.” “Not Detected” would imply batch-specific analytical testing with a defined detection limit, and I could not locate a current public Symrise batch-specific Aprifloren® allergen certificate supporting that stronger statement.



EU COSMETIC LABELLING THRESHOLDS

Where a regulated fragrance allergen is present in the finished cosmetic product, individual labelling is required above:

Finished Product Type	Threshold
Leave-On Products	0.001% (10 ppm)
Rinse-Off Products	0.01% (100 ppm)

These thresholds are confirmed by the European Commission's current fragrance-allergen guidance.

STATEMENT OF CONFORMITY

Based on the information presently available, Aprifloren® – Symrise does not itself trigger individual EU fragrance-allergen declaration.

The finished-product manufacturer remains responsible for evaluating the complete fragrance formulation and determining whether any regulated allergen contributed by other ingredients exceeds the applicable labelling threshold.
