no individually declarable EU fragrance allergen has been identified as an intentional constituent of the material.

DECLARABLE EU FRAGRANCE ALLERGENS IDENTIFIED: NONE

I recommend using “None Identified” rather than “Not Detected.” A statement of “Not Detected” implies batch-specific analytical testing and an established detection limit, and I did not locate a manufacturer-issued quantitative allergen analysis for Aquaphore.

EU COSMETIC LABELLING THRESHOLDS

Where an Annex III fragrance allergen is present in the finished cosmetic product:

Finished Product Type	Individual Labelling Threshold
Leave-On Products	>0.001% (10 ppm)
Rinse-Off Products	>0.01% (100 ppm)



The European Commission confirms these thresholds and notes that Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 added 56 additional fragrance allergens to the individual-labelling regime.

STATEMENT OF CONFORMITY

Based on the available chemical-identity and product information, Aquaphore – Aquatic Floral (2-(4-methylphenoxy)ethanol, CAS 15149-10-7) is not itself identified as an individually declarable EU fragrance allergen.

No declarable fragrance allergen has been identified as an intentional constituent from the documentation reviewed.

The manufacturer of the finished cosmetic or fragrance product remains responsible for evaluating the complete formulation and determining whether any regulated fragrance allergen contributed by other ingredients exceeds the applicable EU labelling threshold.
