REGULATORY BASIS

This declaration has been prepared in accordance with the fragrance allergen requirements of: Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009 on Cosmetic Products including the expanded fragrance allergen requirements applicable under the EU Cosmetics Regulation.

Fragrance allergens must be individually labelled in the finished cosmetic product when present at concentrations of:

Leave-On Products: 10 ppm (0.001%) or higher
Rinse-Off Products: 100 ppm (0.01%) or higher

These are the thresholds stated in the supplied allergen declaration.
