Declaration

Green Hojari Frankincense Essential Oil is a natural complex substance. The reported fragrance allergens occur naturally in the essential oil and are not necessarily intentionally added as separate ingredients.

The composition of a natural essential oil may vary according to:

- Geographical origin;
- Harvesting period;
- Resin grade;
- Environmental conditions;
- Distillation parameters; and
- Individual production batch.

The concentrations shown above are reported ranges taken from the available safety and technical documentation. They are not presented as batch-specific analytical results.

Cosmetic Labelling Thresholds

Where applicable under Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009, fragrance allergens must be declared in the finished cosmetic product when their concentration exceeds:

- 0.001% in leave-on products; or
- 0.01% in rinse-off products.

The manufacturer of the finished cosmetic product is responsible for calculating the concentration contributed by this material together with the contribution from all other ingredients in the formulation.

Important Information

This declaration:

- Applies to the raw material identified above;
- Does not replace a finished-product cosmetic safety assessment;
- Does not replace batch-specific GC-MS testing;



- Does not certify that unlisted fragrance allergens are completely absent;
- Must be reviewed if the composition or supplier specification changes; and
- Must be used together with the applicable SDS, IFRA certificate and finished-product formulation.

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
