REGULATORY BASIS

This declaration has been prepared with reference to:

- Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009 on Cosmetic Products
- Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 concerning the labelling of fragrance allergens
- The expanded fragrance-allergen requirements under Annex III

Fragrance allergens must be declared in the ingredient list of a finished cosmetic product when their concentration exceeds:

- 0.001% in leave-on products
- 0.01% in rinse-off products

INTENTIONALLY ADDED ALLERGENS

No fragrance allergen, carrier, diluent, stabiliser or preservative is declared as intentionally added to the product.

The material is supplied as a Patchouli absolute produced from *Pogostemon cablin* leaves and twigs through solvent extraction followed by removal of the extraction solvent.

QUANTITATIVE DECLARATION

The available manufacturer's Certificate of Analysis for batch 25090080-1 reports appearance, odour, refractive index and specific gravity. It does not provide a quantitative GC-MS profile or concentrations for the expanded EU fragrance allergens.

Accordingly, substances shown as "not quantitatively reported" must not be represented as absent or below the EU labelling thresholds.

A batch-specific quantitative GC-MS allergen report would be required to:

- Confirm the concentration of each naturally occurring allergen
- Determine the precise contribution to the finished cosmetic product
- Support definitive ingredient-labelling calculations
- Declare non-detection at a specified analytical detection limit

CUSTOMER RESPONSIBILITY

The manufacturer or Responsible Person for the finished cosmetic product must assess the complete formulation and determine whether any fragrance allergen exceeds the applicable declaration threshold.

The customer must not rely on the absence of a substance from the manufacturer's SDS or COA as confirmation that the substance is analytically absent.



REGULATORY CONCLUSION

Green Patchouli Absolute – Indonesia is not identified as a prohibited cosmetic fragrance ingredient under the cited EU cosmetic regulation.

Naturally occurring Beta-Caryophyllene, Limonene and Pinenes may require declaration in the finished product when their calculated concentrations exceed the applicable leave-on or rinse-off thresholds.
