The Symrise commercial specification is: MINIMUM 98% GC – SUM OF ISOMERS

This does not analytically prove that every possible fragrance allergen is present at exactly 0.0000%.

Therefore, for a customer requesting a manufacturer-certified quantitative statement for every allergen under the expanded EU list, use the latest original Symrise quantitative allergen declaration for Product 142048.
