PRINCIPAL SUBSTANCE ALLERGEN STATUS

The principal Mugetanol substance:

1-(4-ISOPROPYLCYCLOHEXYL)ETHANOL
CAS 63767-86-2

is not itself identified as one of the traditional individually declarable EU fragrance allergens.
The chemical identity of Mugetanol is distinct from traditional Annex III allergens such as Limonene, Linalool, Citral, Geraniol, Hydroxycitronellal and Coumarin.

EXPANDED EU ALLERGEN FRAMEWORK

I did not locate a public original Symrise quantitative allergen certificate for Mugetanol Product 600092 covering the complete expanded EU 2023/1545 list.

A supplier-document marketplace does show that an allergen declaration exists for Mugetanol, but the indexed result does not expose the quantitative contents.

Therefore, the correct statement is:

NO EU FRAGRANCE ALLERGEN IS IDENTIFIED FROM THE PRINCIPAL CHEMICAL IDENTITY OF MUGETANOL ITSELF.

However, an absolute claim that all expanded allergens equal 0.0000% should only be made from the current quantitative manufacturer/supplier declaration.

EU COSMETIC LABELLING THRESHOLDS

For individually listed fragrance allergens, declaration in the finished cosmetic is generally required when the relevant substance exceeds:

Leave-on cosmetic	0.001% / 10 ppm
Rinse-off cosmetic	0.010% / 100 ppm

IMPORTANT DISTINCTION

Mugetanol may have occupational or environmental hazard classifications in SDS documentation, but SDS hazard classification is separate from EU Annex III fragrance-allergen labelling. For example, Mugetanol appears in fragrance-mixture SDS data with aquatic hazard coding, but that does not itself make CAS 63767-86-2 an individually declarable EU fragrance allergen.

FORMAL DECLARATION

Based on the disclosed chemical identity:

MUGETANOL – SYMRISE
 PRODUCT NO. 600092
 CAS 63767-86-2

is not itself identified as a traditional individually declarable EU fragrance allergen.

No traditional fragrance allergen is identified from the principal substance identity.



For definitive quantitative compliance with the full expanded EU fragrance-allergen framework, the latest manufacturer-issued allergen declaration for Mugetanol should be used.
