EU 2023/1545 Qualification

Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 expanded the list of fragrance allergens requiring individual cosmetic labelling.



Based on Synarome's current published regulatory classification, Piperonyl Acetate remains categorized as allergen free.

For formal customer submissions requiring quantitative detection limits or batch-specific impurity data, the current Synarome regulatory statement should take precedence.

Finished Cosmetic Declaration Thresholds

Where any declarable fragrance allergen is contributed by other fragrance raw materials, the finished cosmetic labelling thresholds remain:

The contribution of each allergen from the entire fragrance formulation must be assessed

Finished Product Assessment

Although Piperonyl Acetate itself is declared allergen free, the finished fragrance may contain allergens from:

- Essential oils
- Absolutes
- Botanical extracts
- Other aroma chemicals
- Fragrance bases
- Accords
- Solvents or carriers containing regulated constituents

The complete finished formulation must therefore be reviewed independently.

Declaration

Based on the manufacturer's published regulatory information:



- Piperonyl Acetate is CAS 326-61-4.
- Manufacturer: Synarome.
- Reference: 000233.
- Synarome declares the material Allergen Free.
- Piperonyl Acetate itself is not identified as an individually declarable EU fragrance allergen.
- No intentionally added EU fragrance allergens are declared.
- No blanket allergen-free claim is made for a finished perfume or cosmetic containing other ingredients.
- Finished cosmetic labelling remains dependent upon the complete formula.
- The cosmetic manufacturer or EU Responsible Person remains responsible for final regulatory compliance.

This declaration applies only to the identified raw material.
