REGULATORY STATEMENT

Based on the manufacturer's batch-specific Certificate of Analysis and available composition information, the fragrance allergen reported above is naturally occurring in Priprioca Essential Oil.

No fragrance allergens are intentionally added to this product. Priprioca Essential Oil is supplied as a natural essential oil obtained through steam distillation of *Cyperus articulatus* roots.



Unlike the Lemon Verbena material referenced in the Eden Botanicals document, Priprioca Essential Oil is not identified as a prohibited fragrance ingredient under Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009.

EU LABELLING THRESHOLDS

Under Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009, as amended by Regulation (EU) 2023/1545, individual fragrance allergens must be declared in the ingredient list of the finished cosmetic product when their concentration exceeds:

- 0.001% in leave-on cosmetic products
- 0.01% in rinse-off cosmetic products

The manufacturer or Responsible Person for the finished cosmetic product must calculate the allergen contribution from Priprioca Essential Oil and all other ingredients in the complete formulation.

CALCULATED PINENES CONTRIBUTION

Based on the batch-specific Alpha-Pinene result of 3.09%:

At the reported concentration, Alpha-Pinene would exceed the 0.001% leave-on labelling threshold when Priprioca Essential Oil is used above approximately 0.0324% in the finished product.

It would exceed the 0.01% rinse-off labelling threshold when Priprioca Essential Oil is used above approximately 0.3236% in the finished product.

PLEASE NOTE

The reported Alpha-Pinene concentration is based on the manufacturer's batch-specific Certificate of Analysis for lot 25747-25.
