TRADITIONAL EU FRAGRANCE ALLERGENS

The source declaration uses dashes rather than quantitative zero values, so “Not identified” is more defensible than writing 0.0000%.

EU 2023/1545 EXPANDED ALLERGEN DECLARATION

The newer Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 expands the fragrance-allergen labelling framework beyond the traditional list.

For this natural Vetiver oil, I would state:

VETIVERIA ZIZANIOIDES ROOT OIL IS NOT ITSELF AN INDIVIDUALLY DECLARABLE EU FRAGRANCE ALLERGEN.

However, because Vetiver Essential Oil is a Natural Complex Substance, exact concentrations of the newly expanded allergens should be based on a current Haiti-specific quantitative allergen analysis rather than inferred from botanical identity alone.

A commercial Haiti-specific Vetiver supplier currently provides a dedicated EU Fragrance Allergen Statement, confirming that this type of product is handled through material-specific allergen documentation.

Based on the available Vetiver Essential Oil allergen declaration reviewed, none of the traditional individually declarable EU fragrance allergens are identified in the material.

Because this product is a naturally variable essential oil, this statement should not be interpreted as laboratory confirmation that every allergen is present at exactly 0.0000%. Where exact quantitative values under the expanded Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 are required, batch-specific analytical/manufacturer documentation should prevail.
