Clove Bud Essential Oil CO₂ is obtained by supercritical carbon dioxide extraction of the dried flower buds of *Syzygium aromaticum*. As a natural botanical extract, its composition may vary according to origin, harvest conditions and extraction parameters. Quantitative allergen concentrations should be confirmed by batch-specific GC-MS analysis where regulatory disclosure is required.
