Declaration

Fennel Essential Oil (Australia) is obtained by steam distillation of the seeds or dried fruits of *Foeniculum vulgare* var. *dulce*. It is a natural complex substance, and its allergen profile may vary according to cultivar, harvest, geographical conditions and distillation parameters.

Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 amended the EU Cosmetics Regulation concerning the labelling of fragrance allergens.
