REGULATORY BASIS

Prepared with reference to:

- Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009
- Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 concerning fragrance allergen labelling.

DECLARATION

Green Patchouli Absolute is a natural complex substance obtained from *Pogostemon cablin* leaves.

No isolated fragrance allergens are intentionally added. Naturally occurring fragrance allergens may be present at varying concentrations depending upon the botanical source, harvest season, extraction process and production batch.

REPRESENTATIVE EU FRAGRANCE ALLERGENS

Limonene	Naturally occurring, batch dependent
Linalool	Naturally occurring, batch dependent
Geraniol	Trace or batch dependent
Citral	Trace or batch dependent

Other regulated fragrance allergens	Batch dependent

Batch-specific analytical data should always be used where available.

FINISHED PRODUCT DECLARATION THRESHOLDS

Product Type	Threshold
Leave-on cosmetics	0.001%
Rinse-off cosmetics	0.01%

Where any regulated allergen exceeds the applicable threshold in the finished cosmetic product, it must be declared on the ingredient label in accordance with EU legislation.

OXIDATION

Natural constituents may oxidise during prolonged exposure to air, heat and light, potentially increasing skin sensitisation potential. Proper storage in tightly closed containers is recommended.

CONCLUSION

Green Patchouli Absolute contains naturally occurring fragrance constituents that may require declaration depending on batch composition and finished-product concentration. Compliance with EU cosmetic labelling requirements remains the responsibility of the finished-product manufacturer.
