REGULATORY BASIS

This declaration has been prepared with reference to:

- Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009 on cosmetic products.
- Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 concerning the labelling of fragrance allergens in cosmetic products.
- The corrigendum published in November 2025.

DECLARATION

Hexyl Acetate, CAS 142-92-7, is not identified as an individually declarable fragrance allergen in the fragrance-allergen labelling provisions introduced by Regulation (EU) 2023/1545.

Based on the declared composition, no EU-regulated fragrance allergens are intentionally added to this material.

TRACE-LEVEL QUALIFICATION

Because the product is described as naturally derived, trace constituents may vary according to:

- Feedstock origin.
- Natural manufacturing route.
- Purification process.
- Cross-contamination controls.
- Individual production batch.

“Not intentionally added” does not constitute an analytical statement of absolute zero content.

Batch-specific allergen analysis or the original manufacturer’s allergen declaration should be used where precise quantitative certification is required.

COSMETIC LABELLING THRESHOLDS

Regulated fragrance allergens require individual declaration in finished cosmetic products when their concentration exceeds:

Product Type	Declaration Threshold
Leave-on cosmetic products	0.001%
Rinse-off cosmetic products	0.01%

The finished-product manufacturer must calculate allergen contributions from the complete formulation.

CONCLUSION

Based on the declared composition, Hexyl Acetate Natural does not intentionally contain EU-regulated fragrance allergens requiring individual declaration. Final allergen labelling must be based on the complete finished formulation and current batch-specific supplier data.
