REGULATORY BASIS

This declaration has been prepared with reference to:

- Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009 on cosmetic products.
- Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 concerning the individual labelling of fragrance allergens in cosmetic products.
- Applicable amendments and corrigenda in force on the issue date.

DECLARATION

Hexyl Butyrate, CAS 2639-63-6, is not individually listed as a declarable fragrance allergen under the fragrance-allergen provisions introduced by Regulation (EU) 2023/1545.

Based on the representative declared composition:

- No EU-regulated fragrance allergens are intentionally added.
- Hexyl Butyrate itself is not an individually declarable EU fragrance allergen.
- Trace impurities may vary according to the natural feedstock and manufacturing process.
- Batch-specific producer data should be used where quantitative confirmation is required.

NATURAL MATERIAL QUALIFICATION

- Manufacturing route.
- Distillation and purification conditions.

- Cross-contamination controls.
- Production batch.

A batch-specific chromatographic analysis or original manufacturer's allergen certificate should take precedence where exact quantitative values are required.

FINISHED COSMETIC DECLARATION THRESHOLDS

EU-regulated fragrance allergens must generally be individually declared in the finished cosmetic ingredient list when present above:

Finished Cosmetic Type	Labelling Threshold
Leave-on products	0.001%
Rinse-off products	0.01%

These thresholds apply to the concentration of each regulated allergen in the finished cosmetic product, not solely in the fragrance raw material.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE FINISHED-PRODUCT MANUFACTURER

The finished-product manufacturer is responsible for:

- Reviewing the complete formulation.
- Calculating allergen contributions from every ingredient.
- Applying the correct leave-on or rinse-off threshold.
- Maintaining current supplier documentation.
- Updating labels within the applicable regulatory transition periods.
- Completing the cosmetic product safety assessment.

CONCLUSION

Based on the representative declared composition, Hexyl Butyrate Natural does not intentionally contain EU-regulated fragrance allergens requiring individual declaration. Hexyl Butyrate itself is not an individually listed fragrance allergen. Final labelling must be determined from the complete finished formulation and current batch-specific supplier data.
