DECLARATION

Honeysuckle CO₂ Extract is a natural botanical extract. The concentrations of naturally occurring fragrance allergens vary according to botanical origin, harvest season and extraction conditions.

Published compositional data do not indicate the consistent presence of EU-regulated fragrance allergens at fixed concentrations; therefore, any fragrance allergens should be

regarded as **batch dependent** and confirmed by supplier-specific chromatographic analysis.

OXIDATION

Natural botanical extracts may undergo gradual oxidation during storage, potentially altering the concentration of naturally occurring constituents. Store in tightly sealed containers away from heat, air and direct sunlight.
