REGULATORY BASIS

This declaration has been prepared with reference to:

- Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009 on cosmetic products.
- Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 concerning the labelling of fragrance allergens in cosmetic products.

Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 expands the fragrance-allergen labelling requirements and includes a grouped declaration approach for certain natural extracts. For applicable jasmine-derived materials, the prescribed grouped ingredient wording may be “Jasmine Oil/Extract.”

DECLARATION

Jasmine Grandiflorum Absolute is a natural botanical extract. Its constituent profile varies according to harvest, origin, flower maturity, extraction process and production batch.

The material may naturally contain EU-regulated fragrance allergens. Exact percentages cannot be certified without a batch-specific allergen declaration or quantitative chromatographic analysis from the original producer.

FINISHED-PRODUCT LABELLING THRESHOLDS

Individual fragrance allergens must generally be declared in the cosmetic ingredient list when their concentration in the finished product exceeds:

Finished Cosmetic Product	Threshold
Leave-on products	0.001%
Rinse-off products	0.01%

The thresholds apply to the concentration in the finished cosmetic product, not directly to the concentration in this raw material.

REGULATORY GUIDANCE

The cosmetic product manufacturer or responsible person must:

- Obtain the original producer's current batch-specific allergen declaration.
- Calculate allergen contributions from every raw material in the formulation.
- Consider the permitted grouped declaration "Jasmine Oil/Extract" where legally applicable.
- Confirm the correct ingredient nomenclature and transitional requirements for the target market.
- Maintain supporting evidence within the Product Information File.

CONCLUSION

Jasmine Grandiflorum Absolute (Egypt) naturally contains or may contain EU-regulated fragrance allergens. Exact allergen concentrations must be taken from the original manufacturer's batch-specific declaration. The finished-product manufacturer remains responsible for labelling compliance under Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009, as amended by Regulation (EU) 2023/1545.
