REPRESENTATIVE NATURAL ALLERGEN PROFILE

As a natural CO₂ extract, the material naturally contains or may contain the following EU-regulated fragrance allergens depending on harvest season and extraction conditions:

Geraniol	Naturally occurring
Limonene	Naturally occurring
Coumarin	Naturally occurring
Citral	Possible trace constituent

Farnesol	Possible trace constituent

The supercritical CO₂ extraction process preserves a wider range of naturally occurring constituents than steam distillation; allergen concentrations remain batch dependent.

These thresholds apply to the concentration of each individual allergen in the finished cosmetic product.
