CONCLUSION

Linalyl Acetate is not a regulated EU fragrance allergen. Representative high-purity material contains no intentionally added Annex III fragrance allergens, with only possible trace impurities formed during manufacture or oxidation. Final cosmetic labelling should be based on the batch-specific analytical data supplied by the manufacturer.
