Finished Cosmetic Declaration Thresholds



Finished Product	Declaration Threshold
Leave-on products	0.001%
Rinse-off products	0.01%

Finished Product Assessment

The concentration of each declarable allergen in the finished cosmetic must be calculated from:

- Its concentration in Mastic Essential Oil
- The concentration of the oil in the fragrance compound
- The fragrance concentration in the finished cosmetic
- Contributions from all other fragrance ingredients

Declaration

Based on available technical information:

- Mastic Essential Oil naturally contains declarable fragrance allergens, particularly limonene and linalool, with trace levels of other terpenoid allergens possible depending on the batch.
- Exact concentrations are batch dependent.
- No "allergen-free" claim is made.
- Final cosmetic labelling must be based upon batch-specific analytical data and the finished formulation.
- The cosmetic manufacturer or Responsible Person remains responsible for compliance with applicable legislation.
