Declaration

Mastic Leaf Absolute is a natural complex substance obtained by solvent extraction of the leaves of *Pistacia lentiscus*. The composition naturally varies depending upon geographical origin, season and extraction process. The following declaration is based on representative analytical data and literature and should be confirmed by batch-specific GC/MS where regulatory accuracy is required.
