Additional Naturally Occurring Constituents

Published allergen declarations for commercial Mate Absolute also identify Methyl Heptadienone (CAS 1604-28-0) as a naturally occurring constituent that may require declaration depending on its concentration in the finished product.

Finished Cosmetic Declaration Limits

Finished Product	Threshold
Leave-on Products	0.001%
Rinse-off Products	0.01%

These thresholds apply to the finished cosmetic product, not the raw material.
