REGULATORY BASIS

This declaration has been prepared with reference to:

- Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009 on cosmetic products
- Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545
- Annex III fragrance-allergen labelling requirements
- Applicable implementation and transitional provisions

IMPORTANT REGULATORY STATUS

The following botanical extracts are grouped for cosmetic ingredient labelling under the common allergen name:

NARCISSUS EXTRACT

The group includes extracts derived from:

- *Narcissus poeticus*
- *Narcissus pseudonarcissus*
- *Narcissus jonquilla*
- *Narcissus tazetta*

For *Narcissus poeticus*, the listed identifiers include:

MANDATORY COSMETIC LABEL NAME

Where the combined concentration of the relevant *Narcissus* extracts exceeds the applicable threshold in the finished cosmetic product, the ingredient must be declared as:

CALCULATION PRINCIPLE FOR OTHER ALLERGENS

Where an allergen is present in the raw material:

Allergen concentration in Narcissus Absolute × Narcissus Absolute concentration in the fragrance compound × fragrance-compound dosage in the finished cosmetic

Where Narcissus Absolute is added directly:

Allergen concentration in Narcissus Absolute × Narcissus Absolute percentage in the finished cosmetic

COMBINED NARCISSUS EXTRACT CONTRIBUTIONS

Where the cosmetic formula contains more than one relevant Narcissus extract, the contributions must be added together.

This may include extracts of:

- *Narcissus poeticus*
- *Narcissus pseudonarcissus*
- *Narcissus jonquilla*
- *Narcissus tazetta*

The combined concentration determines whether **Narcissus Extract** must be listed.

OXIDATION STATEMENT

Oxidation during storage may:

- Change the concentration of certain fragrance constituents
- Create sensitising oxidation products
- Affect the reliability of older analytical data
- Increase peroxide values

The batch should be stored tightly closed and protected from heat, light and air.

CUSTOMER RESPONSIBILITY

The finished-product manufacturer remains responsible for:

- Confirming the botanical species and CAS identity
- Obtaining the current batch-specific allergen declaration
- Reviewing all traditional and expanded EU fragrance allergens
- Calculating the final Narcissus Extract concentration
- Combining contributions from all Narcissus-derived extracts
- Adding allergen contributions from every other raw material
- Applying the appropriate leave-on or rinse-off threshold
- Applying the mandatory label name Narcissus Extract
- Reviewing applicable transitional implementation dates
- Completing the Cosmetic Product Safety Report
- Ensuring compliance in every intended market

CONCLUSION

Narcissus Absolute obtained from *Narcissus poeticus* is included within the EU fragrance-allergen grouping that must be labelled as:

NARCISSUS EXTRACT

The name must be included in the finished cosmetic ingredient list when the relevant combined Narcissus extract concentration exceeds:

- 0.001% in leave-on products
- 0.01% in rinse-off products

Other naturally occurring fragrance allergens may also require declaration depending on their batch-specific concentrations and the final product formulation.

IMPORTANT LIMITATION

This declaration does not constitute a quantitative batch-specific 82-allergen report.

The table must be supplemented or replaced with current manufacturer analytical data when exact concentrations are required for regulatory calculations.
