ALLERGEN STATUS

Makiang Absolute is a Natural Complex Substance.

No authenticated supplier-issued quantitative EU Fragrance Allergen Declaration or validated GC-MS allergen profile is currently available for this botanical material.

Accordingly, quantitative allergen concentrations have not been assigned.

POTENTIALLY OCCURRING NATURAL FRAGRANCE ALLERGENS

Depending on origin, extraction and harvest conditions, naturally occurring fragrance allergens may be present in trace amounts.

Representative possibilities include:

No quantitative concentrations are declared because validated analytical data are unavailable.

TRIETHYL CITRATE

Triethyl Citrate (CAS **77-93-0**) is **not** classified as a regulated EU fragrance allergen under Annex III.

EU LABELLING THRESHOLDS

Fragrance allergens shall be declared in the finished cosmetic product when present above:

Product Type	Threshold
Leave-on Products	0.001%
Rinse-off Products	0.01%

DECLARATION

Final cosmetic labelling shall be determined using:

- The original supplier's batch-specific allergen declaration.
- Batch GC-MS analytical results.
- The concentration of Makiang Absolute in the finished formulation.
- Contributions from all other fragrance ingredients.

CONCLUSION

No quantitative EU fragrance allergen declaration can be issued from currently available representative technical data.

Batch-specific manufacturer documentation shall always take precedence.
