This declaration has been prepared in accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009, as amended by Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545, using available supplier compositional data and published regulatory information.

The following EU fragrance allergens are naturally present in Aniseed Myrtle Oil:

\*Typical composition for the commercially cultivated trans-anethole chemotype. Natural variation occurs according to geographical origin, harvest season and distillation conditions.

## DECLARATION

Aniseed Myrtle Oil is obtained by steam distillation of the leaves and young twigs of *Syzygium anisatum*.

The oil is naturally rich in trans-Anethole, which is its principal constituent, together with naturally occurring Estragole, and trace amounts of Limonene and Linalool. These constituents are recognised fragrance allergens or regulated constituents under the EU Cosmetics Regulation and should be considered when determining the allergen declaration of the finished cosmetic product.

As with all Natural Complex Substances, the concentration of these constituents may vary according to botanical source, environmental conditions and production method. Final allergen declaration for cosmetic products shall be determined from the complete fragrance formulation and, where appropriate, confirmed by batch-specific analytical data.
