EU FRAGRANCE ALLERGEN DECLARATION

This declaration has been prepared in accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009, as amended by Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545.

Based on available supplier allergen declarations and published compositional data for *Artemisia vulgaris* Essential Oil, the following EU fragrance allergens have been identified as naturally occurring constituents.

*Typical concentrations are based on supplier specifications and published analytical data. Natural variation occurs depending on geographical origin, harvest season, chemotype and distillation conditions.



DECLARATION

Artemisia Essential Oil Extra is obtained by steam distillation of the leaves and flowering tops of *Artemisia vulgaris* L.

Available supplier documentation identifies Linalool and Carvone as the principal EU declarable fragrance allergens present in this Natural Complex Substance, each typically at concentrations not exceeding 1.0%. Minor naturally occurring traces of Limonene and Eugenol may also be present depending on the botanical source and seasonal variation.

As with all natural essential oils, the concentration of naturally occurring constituents varies according to geographical origin, cultivation conditions, harvest period and distillation process. Final allergen declaration for cosmetic products should therefore be determined from the complete fragrance formulation and, where appropriate, supported by batch-specific analytical data.

This certificate is issued to support compliance with:

- Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 relating to fragrance allergen labelling.
