This declaration has been prepared in accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009, as amended by Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545.

Based on published supplier specifications and analytical data for genuine Calabrian Bergamot Essential Oil, the following EU declarable fragrance allergens are naturally present:

Bergapten and related furanocoumarins are responsible for the phototoxicity of traditional cold-pressed bergamot oil. They are not EU declarable fragrance allergens under Annex III but are subject to IFRA phototoxicity restrictions.

DECLARATION

Bergamot Essential Oil Calabria Premium is obtained by cold expression of the fresh peel of *Citrus bergamia* grown in Calabria, Italy.

The oil naturally contains significant quantities of Limonene, Linalool, and smaller amounts of Citral, Geraniol, Citronellol, and Farnesol, all of which are declarable fragrance allergens under the EU Cosmetics Regulation when present above the applicable thresholds in the finished cosmetic product.

As a natural complex substance, the concentration of these constituents may vary according to cultivar, harvest season, climatic conditions and production method.

The manufacturer of the finished cosmetic product remains responsible for evaluating the complete fragrance formulation and determining the final allergen declaration in accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009 and Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545.
