EU FRAGRANCE ALLERGEN DECLARATION

This declaration has been prepared in accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009, as amended by Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545.

Based on the chemical identity of (-)- β -Pinene (CAS 18172-67-3) and the available supplier and regulatory information, Beta Pinene Natural is not itself one of the fragrance allergens listed in Annex III of Regulation (EU) 2023/1545.

Because this material is an isolated natural monoterpene rather than a natural complex substance, it is not expected to contain Annex III fragrance allergens as characteristic constituents. Trace impurities, if present, are manufacturing-dependent and not inherent to the identity of β -pinene.

DECLARATION

Beta Pinene Natural consists predominantly of the naturally occurring monoterpene (-)- β -Pinene isolated from conifer-derived essential oils and oleoresins.

Based on the available technical documentation and the current European Cosmetics Regulation:



- Beta Pinene is not an Annex III declarable fragrance allergen.
- No intentionally added Annex III fragrance allergens are present.
- Any trace impurities, should they occur, are process-dependent and are not expected as characteristic constituents of the purified material.

Where absolute confirmation of allergen absence is required for regulatory or customer-specific purposes, batch-specific GC-MS analysis should be performed, since this declaration is based on the substance identity and available supplier documentation rather than individual batch analysis.

This certificate is issued to support compliance with:
