Buchu Essential Oil is obtained by steam distillation of the leaves of *Agathosma betulina*. As with all natural essential oils, its composition varies according to origin, harvest conditions and distillation parameters. Quantitative allergen concentrations should be confirmed by batch-specific GC-MS analysis where regulatory disclosure is required.
