Declaration

Burley Tobacco Extract CO₂ is obtained by supercritical carbon dioxide extraction of cured leaves of *Nicotiana tabacum*. As with all natural botanical extracts, the chemical composition varies according to cultivar, growing conditions, curing process, harvest and extraction parameters. Quantitative allergen concentrations should be confirmed by batch-specific GC-MS analysis where regulatory disclosure is required.
