Declaration

Based on the supplier Safety Data Sheet and the known composition of the fragrance mixture, Honey Signature contains fragrance substances that are listed under Annex III of Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009, as amended by Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545.

As this is a proprietary fragrance mixture, the complete formulation and quantitative composition are confidential. Consequently, only the fragrance allergens identified from the available supplier information can be declared in this certificate.

The supplier SDS identifies several fragrance constituents including Linalyl Acetate, Piperonal, β -Damascone, trans-Damascenone and other aromatic substances.

Regulatory Statement
