5. Regulatory Statement

Lime Oil Distilled is obtained by steam distillation of the peel of *Citrus aurantiifolia*. Unlike expressed lime oil, the distillation process significantly reduces naturally occurring furocoumarins (including bergapten) responsible for phototoxicity while retaining the characteristic citrus aroma.



This material naturally contains Limonene, together with minor amounts of Linalool, Citral, Geraniol, and Citronellol, which are fragrance allergens listed in Annex III of Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009 and Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545.

Natural variation in allergen content may occur depending on harvest conditions, geographical origin and production batch.

6. Statement of Conformity

Aromology certifies that, based on available supplier information, manufacturing data and compositional review, Lime Oil Distilled (*Citrus aurantiifolia*) has been assessed for the presence of fragrance allergens in accordance with:

- Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009
- Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545

This declaration reflects the typical naturally occurring allergen profile of the material. The manufacturer of the finished cosmetic product remains responsible for determining whether allergen labelling is required based on the concentration of these constituents in the finished cosmetic formulation.
