Declaration

Spearmint Essential Oil CO₂ is a natural extract obtained by supercritical carbon dioxide extraction of the aerial parts of *Mentha spicata*. Based on supplier information, manufacturing knowledge and available analytical data, this material naturally contains fragrance constituents listed in Annex III of Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009, as amended by Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1545.

The concentration of these naturally occurring constituents varies according to harvest season, geographical origin and extraction conditions.
