Declaration

Ylang Oil Fraction – Farnesene is obtained by fractional distillation of the flowers of *Cananga odorata*. As with all natural fractions, composition varies depending on harvest conditions and the fraction collected. Quantitative allergen concentrations should be confirmed by batch-specific GC-MS analysis where regulatory disclosure is required.
