DECLARATION

This certificate provides information regarding the conformity of Narcisse Base 184092 D – Firmenich with the Standards of the International Fragrance Association up to and including the IFRA 51st Amendment.

The maximum permitted concentrations stated below apply to the concentration of Narcisse Base in the final consumer product.

These limits may not remain valid where Narcisse Base is used together with other ingredients containing the same IFRA-restricted substances. The total contribution of every restricted substance from the complete formulation must be considered.

NITROSAMINE-PRECURSOR INFORMATION

The manufacturer certificate identifies the following substance as having potential to form nitrosamines in the presence of nitrosating systems:

Dimethyl Anthranilate via synthetics	85-91-6	0.0004%

Narcisse Base should not be combined with nitrosating agents or systems where nitrosamine formation may occur.

PEROXIDE COMPLIANCE

The manufacturer states that peroxide levels comply with applicable IFRA and EU requirements.

IMPORTANT LIMITATIONS

This certificate:

- Applies only to **Firmenich Narcisse Base 184092 D**.
- Applies to the supplied, unmodified fragrance mixture.
- States maximum concentrations in the final consumer product.
- Does not certify a comprehensive toxicological safety assessment of every constituent.
- Does not replace a finished-product safety assessment.
- Does not account for restricted-substance contributions from other raw materials.
- Does not authorise use in prohibited categories.
- Must not be applied unchanged to a modified or diluted version of the product.

CALCULATION PRINCIPLE

Where Narcisse Base is first incorporated into a fragrance compound, its final concentration is calculated as:

Narcisse Base percentage in fragrance compound × fragrance-compound dosage in finished product

Example

Where:

- Narcisse Base in fragrance concentrate: **10%**
- Fragrance concentrate in finished perfume: **20%**

Final Narcisse Base concentration:

$$10\% \times 20\% = 2.00\%$$

For IFRA Category 4, the maximum permitted level is **38.08%**, so the illustrative 2.00% concentration is within the stated category limit.

This calculation does not account for cumulative restricted substances from other ingredients.

CONDITIONS OF CONFORMITY

Conformity is subject to the following conditions:

- The correct IFRA category is selected.
- The Narcisse Base concentration in the final product does not exceed the stated limit.
- Contributions from all other restricted ingredients are included.
- The product is not used in Categories 1 or 6.
- Nitrosating systems are avoided.
- The current manufacturer certificate remains valid.
- The finished product is appropriately safety assessed.
- Applicable regional and national regulations are followed.

CUSTOMER RESPONSIBILITY

The finished-product manufacturer remains responsible for:

- Confirming the correct product reference.
- Using the latest Firmenich IFRA certificate.
- Selecting the correct IFRA category.
- Calculating the concentration in the final product.
- Assessing cumulative restricted-substance exposure.
- Reviewing the complete fragrance formula.
- Reviewing allergen and cosmetic-regulatory requirements.
- Completing the finished-product safety assessment.

- Maintaining appropriate regulatory and batch records.
- Ensuring legal compliance in the intended market.

CONCLUSION

Based on Firmenich's IFRA 51st Amendment Certificate for **Narcisse Base 184092 D**, the maximum permitted concentration in the final product ranges from **0.86% to 38.08%**, depending on the IFRA category.

The material is:

- **Not permitted in Categories 1 and 6**
- **Unrestricted under IFRA in Categories 10B and 12**
- **Restricted to the category-specific maximum levels stated in this certificate for all other categories**
