#### IFRA STATEMENT

This certificate provides information regarding the compliance of the above-mentioned fragrance ingredient with the International Fragrance Association (IFRA) Standards – 51<sup>st</sup> Amendment.

Angelica Roots Essential Oil is a Natural Complex Substance (NCS) obtained by steam distillation of the roots of *Angelica archangelica* L.

The material is subject to IFRA Standard 086 due to the presence of naturally occurring phototoxic furocoumarins (including bergapten and related compounds). The restriction applies to products intended for skin exposure and is designed to minimize the risk of phototoxic reactions.

For applications involving skin contact, the use level of Angelica Roots Essential Oil shall comply with the concentration limits specified in IFRA Standard 086. Where multiple phototoxic fragrance ingredients are present in the same fragrance, their combined contribution shall be assessed in accordance with the IFRA Standards.

## **COMPLIANCE**

Angelica Roots Essential Oil may be used in fragrance compounds provided that:

- The finished fragrance complies with the requirements of IFRA Standard 086.
  - The contribution of naturally occurring phototoxic constituents is taken into account.
  - Where other phototoxic ingredients are present, cumulative exposure is evaluated in accordance with IFRA guidance.

## **DECLARATION**

To the best of our knowledge and based on available supplier documentation and published IFRA information, Angelica Roots Essential Oil conforms to the IFRA Standards – 51st Amendment, provided that it is used within the applicable limits of IFRA Standard 086 for the intended product category.

The responsibility for ensuring compliance of the finished fragrance compound with the applicable IFRA Product Category remains with the fragrance manufacturer.
