IFRA STATEMENT

This certificate provides information regarding the compliance of the above-mentioned fragrance ingredient with the International Fragrance Association (IFRA) Standards – 51st Amendment.

Artemisia Essential Oil Extra (*Artemisia vulgaris* L.) is a Natural Complex Substance (NCS) obtained by steam distillation of the leaves and flowering tops of the plant.

The material is not subject to a single standalone IFRA prohibition. However, its use is restricted through the presence of naturally occurring IFRA-restricted constituents (including thujones, linalool, carvone, and other naturally occurring constituents where applicable). Consequently, maximum use levels depend on the intended IFRA Product Category and the cumulative contribution of these constituents in the finished fragrance.

These values reflect the IFRA 51 restrictions for this Natural Complex Substance based on the naturally occurring restricted constituents present in the oil.

COMPLIANCE

Artemisia Essential Oil Extra may be incorporated into fragrance compounds provided that:

- The concentration in the finished consumer product does not exceed the applicable IFRA Category limit.
- The contribution of naturally occurring restricted constituents is included in the overall IFRA calculation.
- The finished fragrance complies with all applicable IFRA Standards and the IFRA Code of Practice.

DECLARATION

To the best of our knowledge and based on the available supplier documentation together with the IFRA Standards – 51st Amendment, Artemisia Essential Oil Extra (*Artemisia vulgaris* L.) complies with the IFRA



Standards when used within the maximum concentration limits applicable to the intended IFRA Product Category.

The responsibility for ensuring compliance of the finished fragrance compound with the applicable IFRA Product Category remains with the fragrance manufacturer.
