IFRA STATEMENT

This certificate provides information regarding the compliance of the above-mentioned fragrance ingredient with the International Fragrance Association (IFRA) Standards – 51st Amendment.

Bergamot Essential Oil Calabria Premium is a Natural Complex Substance (NCS) obtained by cold expression of the fresh peel of *Citrus bergamia*.

This material naturally contains furanocoumarins, principally bergapten (5-methoxypsoralen), which are phototoxic. Consequently, the use of cold-pressed bergamot oil is restricted under the IFRA Standards. The permitted use levels shown below are established to control consumer exposure to phototoxic furanocoumarins in finished fragrance products.

These limits apply to cold-pressed bergamot oil containing naturally occurring bergapten and are derived from the IFRA Standard addressing phototoxic fragrance ingredients.

RESTRICTED CONSTITUENTS

Naturally Occurring Constituent Typical Content

Bergapten (5-MOP)	0.10–0.40%
Bergamottin	Naturally Present
Limonene	30–45%
Linalyl Acetate	22–36%
Linalool	6–15%

The phototoxic restriction is determined by the naturally occurring furanocoumarins, particularly bergapten (5-MOP).

COMPLIANCE

Bergamot Essential Oil Calabria Premium may be incorporated into fragrance compounds provided that:



- The concentration in the finished consumer product does not exceed the applicable IFRA Category limit.
 - Total exposure to naturally occurring furanocoumarins complies with the current IFRA Standard.
 - The finished fragrance complies with all applicable IFRA Standards and the intended IFRA Product Category.
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DECLARATION

To the best of our knowledge and based upon the IFRA Standards – 51st Amendment, Bergamot Essential Oil Calabria Premium (Cold Pressed) complies with IFRA requirements when used within the maximum concentration limits applicable to the intended IFRA Product Category.

This certificate applies solely to the raw material identified above.

The responsibility for ensuring compliance of the finished fragrance compound with the applicable IFRA Product Category remains with the fragrance manufacturer.

REGULATORY NOTE

This certificate applies only to the raw material identified above.

For FCF (Furanocoumarin-Free) Bergamot Oil, substantially higher use levels may be permitted because the phototoxic constituents have been removed. This certificate applies only to traditional cold-pressed Bergamot Essential Oil containing naturally occurring furanocoumarins.
