IFRA Statement

This certificate confirms that Lime Oil Distilled (*Citrus aurantiifolia*) has been evaluated in accordance with the International Fragrance Association (IFRA) Standards, 51st Amendment (June 2023).

Steam distillation substantially reduces naturally occurring furocoumarins (including bergapten) responsible for the phototoxicity associated with expressed lime oil. Accordingly, distilled lime oil is generally not subject to the phototoxicity restrictions applicable to expressed lime oil, provided it complies with the compositional requirements of the IFRA Standards.

Phototoxicity Statement

Steam distilled lime oil contains significantly reduced levels of furocoumarins compared with cold-pressed (expressed) lime oil. Consequently, it is generally regarded as non-phototoxic and is not subject to the IFRA phototoxicity limits applicable to expressed citrus peel oils, provided the material meets the relevant IFRA compositional specifications.
