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#### Basis of Declaration

A verified, current IFF IFRA 51 Certificate containing the category-specific maximum concentrations for the exact Aquaflora TOCO commercial grade was not available for inclusion in this document.

The IFRA status of every constituent in the commercial grade must be reviewed from the current manufacturer documentation.

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### Cumulative Restricted-Material Assessment

The finished formula must include contributions from:

- Aquaflora TOCO
- Other aldehydic fragrance materials
- Related polycyclic materials
- Tocopherol
- Stabiliff constituents
- Essential oils
- Absolutes
- Botanical extracts
- Fragrance bases
- Other aroma chemicals
- Solvents and carriers
- Functional ingredients

Where the same restricted constituent is present from multiple raw materials, all contributions must be added cumulatively.

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### Conditional Conformity Statement

Aquaflora TOCO may be used only when:

1. The exact commercial product has been identified.
2. The current IFF IFRA Certificate has been obtained.
3. The intended IFRA category has been selected.
4. The applicable manufacturer maximum has been applied.



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5. All restricted constituents have been calculated cumulatively.
6. The complete finished product has undergone an appropriate safety assessment.

No universal or unrestricted maximum is certified by this template.

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### Additional Safety Considerations

IFRA conformity does not independently establish compliance with:

- Skin sensitisation assessment
- Eye irritation requirements
- Inhalation exposure limits

No unsupported numerical IFRA maximum is assigned in this document.
