2. The current composition is consistent with the assessed identity.
3. No separately restricted constituent is introduced at a relevant concentration.
4. The complete fragrance formula is assessed against all applicable IFRA Standards.
5. The intended finished-product category is correctly selected.
6. The finished product undergoes an appropriate safety assessment.
7. Regional regulatory requirements are satisfied.
