Due to the possibility of incidental oral ingestion, an approved flavour-material status as defined by the IOFI Code of Practice is required.

This certificate does not include confirmation of flavour-use conformity.

Category 7A – Not Restricted

Rinse-off hair treatments, chemical hair treatments, relaxers and rinse-off hair dyes.

Category 7B – Not Restricted

Hair sprays, styling products, leave-on conditioners, leave-on hair treatments, dry shampoo and hair perfume.

Category 8 – Not Restricted

Intimate wipes, intimate deodorants, tampons, baby wipes and wet toilet paper.

Category 9 – Not Restricted

Bar soap, shampoo, rinse-off conditioner, facial cleanser, liquid soap, body wash, shower gel, bath products and shaving preparations.

Category 10A – Not Restricted

Hand-wash detergents, household cleaners, laundry pre-treatment products, reed diffusers and similar household products.

Category 10B – Not Restricted

Aerosol air fresheners, animal sprays and aerosol insecticides.

Category 11A – Not Restricted

Conventional feminine hygiene products, baby diapers, incontinence products and dry toilet paper.



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Category 11B – Not Restricted

Facial tissues, paper towels, pillow sprays, scented textiles and similar products.

Category 12 – Not Restricted

Candles, incense, machine-wash detergents, automated air fresheners, plug-ins, closed air-care systems and other products with no significant skin contact.

ORAL-EXPOSURE REQUIREMENTS

Use in IFRA Categories 1 and 6 may result in incidental oral ingestion.

For these applications:

- The material must possess an approved flavour-material status.
- The status should comply with the IOFI Code of Practice.
- This certificate does not confirm flavour-use compliance.
