Declaration

We hereby certify that Fir Balsam Absolute has been reviewed with reference to the International Fragrance Association Code of Practice and IFRA Standards, 51st Amendment.

Fir Balsam Absolute is a Natural Complex Substance (NCS). The complete absolute does not have one universal maximum use level applicable to every batch and product category. Its compliance must be assessed from the concentration of any IFRA-regulated constituents identified in the batch and their total contribution from all ingredients in the finished fragrance.

Typical naturally occurring constituents may include limonene, α -pinene, β -pinene, bornyl acetate, camphene, borneol and related terpenes. Oxidised terpenes may also contribute to skin-sensitisation potential. Published safety information for Fir Balsam Absolute classifies the material as capable of causing an allergic skin reaction.
