We hereby certify that Fir Essential Oil (Abies Oil) – East Himalayan has been evaluated with reference to the International Fragrance Association (IFRA) Code of Practice and IFRA Standards (51st Amendment).

This material is a Natural Complex Substance (NCS). Compliance with IFRA requirements depends on the concentration of naturally occurring restricted constituents and their total contribution in the finished fragrance formulation.

Fir essential oils naturally contain constituents such as limonene, α -pinene, β -pinene, bornyl acetate and δ -3-carene. In accordance with IFRA guidance for Pinaceae-derived essential oils, peroxide levels should be maintained at the lowest practicable level, for example through the use of antioxidants during production and storage.

Categories 1–12	Use in accordance with Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP). Compliance shall be determined from batch-specific analytical data and the applicable IFRA Standards for naturally occurring constituents.
