DECLARATION

Golden Virginia Tobacco Absolute has been reviewed with reference to the IFRA Standards under the 51st Amendment.

IFRA identifies tobacco leaf absolute and tobacco extract in its fragrance ingredient glossary, including tobacco leaf absolute under CAS 8037-19-2.

The material is a complex botanical extract and is not assigned a single universal maximum-use concentration in this statement.

IFRA explains that raw-material suppliers should communicate conformity and constituent information, while the formal Certificate of Conformity is generally established for fragrance mixtures rather than individual raw materials.

BASIS OF ASSESSMENT

The permitted use level must be determined from:

- The actual batch composition.



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- The nicotine content.
- The residual-solvent profile.
- The intended IFRA finished-product category.
- Any IFRA-restricted constituents present in the extract.
- Contributions from all other fragrance materials.
- The finished-product exposure and toxicological assessment.
- Applicable national and regional legislation.
