Helichrysum Absolute is a Natural Complex Substance (NCS) and has been evaluated with reference to the IFRA 51st Amendment.

This material is subject to IFRA constituent-based restrictions. Compliance is determined by calculating naturally occurring restricted constituents within the finished fragrance rather than by applying a single universal use limit. IFRA publishes estimated concentrations of regulated constituents for this natural ingredient to support compliance calculations.

- Constituent restrictions do not apply.
