DECLARATION

Ho Wood Essential Oil is a Natural Complex Substance (NCS) obtained by steam distillation of the wood of *Cinnamomum camphora* var. *linaloolifera*.

Under the IFRA 51st Amendment, Ho Wood Essential Oil is not subject to a dedicated IFRA Standard with a universal maximum use level. Compliance must therefore be established by evaluating the naturally occurring restricted constituents within the complete fragrance formulation.

Because Ho Wood Oil is naturally rich in linalool, IFRA recommends maintaining peroxide levels as low as reasonably practicable. The use of suitable antioxidants (for example, BHT or α -tocopherol) is recommended to minimise oxidation of linalool-rich materials.

CONDITIONS OF COMPLIANCE

Finished-product compliance requires:

- Selection of the applicable IFRA product category.
- Assessment of naturally occurring restricted constituents.
- Evaluation of the complete fragrance composition.
- Batch-specific analytical verification where appropriate.
- Monitoring peroxide values during storage of this linalool-rich essential oil.
- Final toxicological assessment of the finished fragrance.

IMPORTANT NOTES

This declaration does not imply:

- Unlimited use of the raw material.
- Automatic compliance of finished fragrances.
- Exemption from constituent-based IFRA assessment.

CONCLUSION

Ho Wood Essential Oil conforms with the IFRA 51st Amendment when the complete fragrance formulation is evaluated for its intended application. No universal IFRA maximum use percentage is assigned.
