### DECLARATION

Honeysuckle CO<sub>2</sub> Extract is a Natural Complex Substance (NCS) obtained by supercritical carbon dioxide extraction of the flowers of *Lonicera japonica*.

The material has been reviewed with reference to the IFRA Standards, 51st Amendment.

No specific IFRA Standard assigning a universal maximum use level has been identified for Honeysuckle CO<sub>2</sub> Extract. Compliance is therefore achieved by evaluating any naturally occurring restricted constituents together with all other ingredients present in the finished fragrance formulation.
