DECLARATION

Indian Red Rose Oil Otto is a Natural Complex Substance (NCS) obtained by steam distillation of fresh *Rosa indica* flowers.

The material has been reviewed with reference to the International Fragrance Association Standards, 51st Amendment.

No universal IFRA maximum use level is assigned to Indian Red Rose Oil Otto as a complete natural raw material. Finished-fragrance compliance must be determined by assessing the concentration of naturally occurring constituents that may be subject to individual IFRA Standards.

CONDITIONS OF COMPLIANCE

Finished-product assessment must include:

- Selection of the applicable IFRA product category.
 - Review of the complete fragrance formulation.
 - Quantification of relevant restricted constituents.
 - Consideration of contributions from all fragrance ingredients.
 - Batch-specific chromatographic analysis where required.
 - Final safety and toxicological evaluation of the intended end product.
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IMPORTANT LIMITATION

This statement does not mean that:

- The raw material may be used without limitation.
 - Every finished formulation is automatically IFRA compliant.
 - The contribution of restricted natural constituents may be disregarded.
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CONCLUSION

Indian Red Rose Oil Otto – *Rosa indica* may be used in accordance with the IFRA Standards, 51st Amendment, provided the completed fragrance formulation is assessed for the intended product category. No universal IFRA maximum use level is assigned to the raw material itself.
