2-Isobutylquinoline is a classic leather aroma chemical used in trace amounts to create leather, chypre, tobacco and moss accords. Recent RIFM safety assessments conclude that, under current declared levels of use, there are no identified concerns for skin sensitisation, photoirritation or photoallergenicity.

IFRA Compliance Statement

At the time of preparation, 2-Isobutylquinoline (CAS 93-19-6) is not subject to an individual ingredient restriction in the IFRA Standards (51st Amendment).

However, the maximum permitted level in a finished product depends on the complete fragrance composition and the IFRA category of the end product.



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Published IFRA certificates supplied by fragrance distributors for Isobutyl Quinoline indicate compliance with the 51st Amendment, with category-specific limits applying to the finished fragrance mixture, not to the neat raw material itself.

IFRA Guidance

The finished fragrance must be evaluated by considering:

- Concentration of Isobutyl Quinoline in the fragrance concentrate.
- Contributions from all other IFRA-restricted ingredients.
- Intended IFRA application category.
- Final concentration of the fragrance in the finished consumer product.

No universal restriction applies to the neat raw material alone.

Maximum Use Levels

IFRA Category	Maximum Level
Categories 1–12	No ingredient-specific restriction for the neat raw material*

*Final finished-product limits depend upon the complete fragrance formulation and IFRA category assessment.

Declaration

Based on the currently available IFRA documentation:

- Isobutyl Quinoline-2 complies with the IFRA Standards (51st Amendment).
 - No ingredient-specific IFRA restriction has been identified for the neat material.
 - The finished fragrance must be assessed against the complete IFRA Standard using the full formulation.
 - Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) should be followed.
